## Questions to ask when presenting to a GP with Urinary Symptoms

What tests do you recommend because:
I have visible blood in my urine
I have a different feeling when I urinate
I have pain when I urinate
My flow when I urinate has changed
My frequency and/or urgency to urinate have increased
Is there any specific medical history important to tell you as a patient with my symptoms?
Chronic urinary tract infections (UTI's)
• Smoker
Worked in an industry using chemicals
• Diabetes
Family history
What do you mean when you say I have microscopic or macroscopic haematuria?
What are the potential diagnoses for a patient with haematuria?
I feel my symptoms are not improving or while they have improved a little, have not gone away completely. Is there any further imaging or tests (ultrasound, CT scan, MRI, blood tests, urinalysis) I should consider to further diagnose why I am experiencing these symptoms?  To rule in/out Urinary Tract Infection (UTI)  To look for any more serious causes  What do these test involve?  What could they show you to help with my diagnosis?  Can I be referred to a Urologist for further assessment?
Which tests are covered by Medicare? If not covered by Medicare, what would the cost be?
How quickly can I get an appointment for the tests I require?
