Questions to ask when presenting to a Urologist after pathology has been performed on a bladder tumour

□ What kind of tumour or cancer do I have?

- Muscle invasive / non-muscle invasive
- Malignant / non-malignant
- High grade / low grade
- □ What type of cancer is it?
 - Urothelial
 - Squamous cell
 - Adenocarcinoma
 - Small cell
 - Other rarer type
- □ What is the stage of my cancer (Ta, Tis, T1, T2, T3, T4)?
- □ How aggressive is my cancer?
- □ Where is the cancer at the moment?
- □ Has it spread or could it spread to other parts of my body?
- □ How common is my cancer?
- □ Are there any further imaging or tests (ultrasound, CT scan, MRI, bone scan, PET scan), I need to have?
 - What do these tests involve?
 - What could they show you?
- □ Which tests are covered by Medicare? If not covered my Medicare, what would the costs be?
- □ I do/do not have private health insurance:
 - What is the impact financially?
 - What is the impact for expediency of treatment?
- How quickly can I get an appointment for these additional tests?
